INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the tool

- Understanding what are the conditions where ecosystem participants would commit to the activities and when they would prefer to "step out"
- Defining the ecosystem basic principles for the participation in the ecosystem







Workshop time: 1 - 2 hours

Recommended methods or tools to use

Physical/online workshops. Online co-creation tools like Miro, Trello, online questionnaires like Typeform, Surveymonkey. Co-creation methods



Challenge

How to prepare the exercise



Send an e-mail to all participants asking them to preconsider and discuss within their organization the questions in the template



Prepare an online questionnaire with the below 5 questions and ask them to fill it in before the workshop



Schedule 1-2-hour workshop



Compile the answers from the online questionnaire into a summary

How to run the workshop



Present the common finding from the online questionnaire. Identify common challenges / opportunities. Discuss each point with the ecosystem participants



Ask questions like why? How could we solve this issue? Try to find common grounds for each point. Remember to stress that the focus for the ecosystem should be kept as open as possible according to open innovation principles.



Agree on common principles for each 5 points. Document it (part 2)



Share the document with the ecosystem participants



Revisit and update this document for the basic principles workshop or any time during the ecosystem lifecycle.

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
