How to prepare the exercise

How to run the workshop



Identify and describe relevant future technologies or technology areas for deep dives



World cafe method – Assign technologies or technology areas to smaller groups of participants that will fill in the key questions per Technology or Technology area – each group gets 15 minute per technology area:



- What will the impact of the technology be for the ecosystem / individual ecosystem actors?
- How could the technology be applied in the context of the ecosystem or by specific ecosystem actors to create value for the ecosystem?
- What is the trend in detail, meaning how will the technology development progress and what larger trend is it connected to (if any)?
- What are concrete examples of value adding applications of the technology?



The main person at the table introduces the results followed by a group discussion to finalize the deep dive per technology / technology area.
